

2023 Batch Students Visit To Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Reddypalli

The field visit to Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Reddypalli was conducted on 03.01.2026 with 3rd year students (2023 batch) of SKCHS under guidance of faculty members Dr Ramanjaneyulu, Dr Basavaraj, Dr. Vidya, Ms Deepika. These students had a chance to understand integrated farming systems at the household level. During the visit, students observed demonstration plots related to agriculture and horticulture crops, highlighting improved cultivation practices. The role of fodder crops in supporting livestock-based livelihoods was explained. The visit provided practical exposure to sustainable and location-specific farming models. Students gained clarity on how different farm enterprises are linked. Overall, the visit strengthened their understanding of IFST concepts.

Students also observed vermicompost units, where the process of converting organic waste into nutrient-rich manure was explained by Dr. V. Madhavalatha, SMS, Crop Production. Kitchen garden models demonstrated the importance of growing vegetables for household nutrition and food security. Backyard poultry units showcased low-cost income-generating opportunities for rural households. Livestock components suitable for small and marginal farmers were also demonstrated. Emphasis was given on recycling farm residues within the system. The visit helped students appreciate integrated approaches for enhancing income, nutrition, and sustainability at the household level.
