SRI ALLURI SEETHA RAMA RAJU BIRTH ANNIVERSARY ON 4th JULY 2024 IN SRI KRISHNADEVARAYA COLLEGE OF HORTICULTURAL SCIENCES (SKCHS), ANANTAPUR.

Sri Alluri Seetha Rama Raju birth anniversary was observed on 4thJuly 2024, at Sri Krishna Devaraya College of Horticultural Sciences, Anantapuramu. The programme was organized with due participation by the staff and students at SKCHS. Dr. N. Narayana Reddy Garu, Associate Dean of SKCHS paid floral tributes to the great leader and also said that Sri Alluri Seetha Rama Raju, popularly known as "Manyam Veerudu" and his efforts are remembered as a significant contribution to India's freedom struggle. Rama Raju was born on July 4th, 1897 at Mogallu in Vishakhapatnam district to Venkatarama Raju Garu and Suryanarayanamma Garu. Alluri Seetha Rama Raju formed a guerrilla army and used guerrilla warfare to launch attacks on British police stations and outposts. Alluri Seetha Rama Raju was captured and killed by British forces in Koyyuru village on 7thmay 1924 marking the end of rampa rebellion. In the programme Mr. M. Sainath Rao and Dr. L. Nagi Reddy, teaching staff briefed contributions of Sri Alluri Seetha Rama Raju to the Nation. Students delivered an informative speech on the life history of Sri Alluri Seetha Rama Raju. All the staff and students paid homage to Sri Alluri Seetha Rama Raju the great leader and the programme ended with formal vote of thanks.
