It serves for collection and maintenance of useful germplasm for various crops and plant species such as *Hildegardia populifolia*, *Cycas andamanica*, Redsander, *Dipicadi krishnadevaraye* *Pimpinella tirupathiensis*, *Pandanus*, *Peltophorum*, *Date palm*, *Nymphea* etc. The garden is spread over an area of approximately 10 acres and is used for teaching and research purposes by the university, Department of Botany. It is also a popular spot for visitors to the university campus.
